FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What makes Lanyon Bowdler different to other personal injury solicitors?

What do I need to prove to be successful in a personal injury claim?

To be successful in a straightforward claim, you need to prove two things:

- That the accident was caused by someone else's negligence or a breach of statutory duty.
- That the negligence/breach caused you physical or mental injury.

What are my chances of winning my case?

We will make an initial assessment of the merits of your case when we first see you. We will continue to review the merits of your case as it progresses. Our assessment will be based upon your own evidence, our research and the significant experience we have in personal injury cases. We assess the prospects of success throughout the conduct of the case and if at any stage we receive evidence that alters our view of the prospects, we shall advise you immediately.

How long will my claim take?

It depends on the complexity of your case. We will give you an estimate once we have more information. Main factors in the length of the claim are the attitude of the Defendant towards settlement, the depth of investigations and your medical prognosis. How will I pay for your services?

EXAMPLE CLAIMS

Claim A

H was a front-seat passenger in a car which was in a high speed collision on the M5. She sustained a fractured sternum, whiplash to the cervical spine, a ligament injury to her shoulder and a psychological injury. These injuries resulted in a serious disability and impacted on her ability to work and on her daily needs.

The driver of the car had legal expenses insurance and their panel firm was initially instructed. H was not offered a face-to-face meeting at any time, and was advised that £16,000 was a good settlement figure. She rejected this, and decided to instruct Lanyon Bowdler who were local to her and had the necessary knowledge and experience. With our expertise, she recovered £400,000 in settlement.

Case B

J was involved in a road traffic accident. Liability for the accident was not in dispute. She suffered from serious multiple injuries including serious lower limb fractures, crushed lumbar vertebrae, internal injuries, very severe scarring, together with a severe head injury giving rise to increased risk of epilepsy, serious psychological problems and hearing loss. J had a protracted period of recovery and was still suffering from ongoing problems. She came to Lanyon Bowdler seven years later. She was disillusioned with her previous solicitor who had prepared a one page Schedule of Loss amounting to £84,000. We met with her and in just over 12 months put the matter before the Court for permission to rely on specialist care expert and an accommodation expert and instructed a QC.

An intensive year of hard work followed which resulted in a joint settlement meeting ahead of the projected trial date and achieved an out of court settlement award for £1.5 million. Had she continued with her previous solicitors expectations for damages were unlikely to have exceeded £300,000.

Injury through someone else's negligence can happen, and the consequences can be life-changing. Livelihoods can be lost and care needed.

We understand this and that bringing a claim can be a daunting prospect. We treat each and every case with professionalism and consideration.
